ADMISSION TO POSTGRADUATE ADMISSION (2025-2027 SESSION)



1. M.Phil. in Clinical Psychology (12 Seats)

Program Overview: This advanced training program prepares students to become competent Clinical Psychologists, skilled in psychological assessment, diagnosis, psychotherapy, rehabilitation, and mental health management. The course emphasizes evidence-based practices to enhance psychological well-being and improve the quality of life for individuals.

Eligibility Criteria: Applicants must have a Master's degree in Psychology (M.A./M.Sc.) from a recognized university with a minimum of 55% marks (50% for SC/ST/OBC) in regular mode.

Duration: A two-year full-time professional training program divided into Part-I and Part-II, providing extensive hands-on experience in clinical settings.

2. M. Phil in Psychiatric Social Work (30 Seats)

Program Overview: This course equips students with specialized skills in psychiatric social work, focusing on mental health interventions, counseling, advocacy, and rehabilitation. It prepares professionals to work with patients, families, caregivers, and community stakeholders, promoting mental health awareness and social integration.

Eligibility Criteria: Candidates must possess a Master's degree in Social Work (MSW) from a recognized university with a minimum of 55% marks (50% for SC/ST/OBC).

Duration: A two-year full-time intensive training program (Part-I and Part-II), integrating practical fieldwork, research, and clinical expertise.

These programs offer rigorous academic training, real-world clinical exposure, and research-driven insights, empowering graduates to make a significant impact in the field of mental health.

GENERAL INSTRUCTION TO THE CANDIDATES

- 1 The institute does not provide accommodation for candidates appearing for the entrance examination.
- 2 No TA/DA (Travel Allowance/Dearness Allowance) will be provided to the Candidates or accompanying members.
- 3 Candidates must bring a blue or black ballpoint pen for filling out the OMR sheet.
- The question booklet will consist of 100 multiple-choice questions (MCQs), based on the prescribed postgraduate syllabus at the national level.
- 5 Candidates must enter the examination hall 30 minutes before the exam begins.
- 6 Leaving the exam hall is allowed only after the completion and submission of the paper.
- 7 The use of electronic devices (such as mobile phones, smart watches, or calculators) is strictly prohibited in the examination hall.
- 8 Marking Scheme:+1 mark for each correct answer.
- 9 -0.25 marks will be deducted for each incorrect response.

Practical Examination and Final Selection:

- A practical/viva-voce examination will be conducted during the interview process, in accordance with Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) norms.
- 2 Candidates must qualify for the written examination to proceed to the practical/viva-voce stage.
- Final selection is based on the candidate's overall performance in the entrance exam and the interview.

DEPARTMENT OF CLINICALPSYCHOLOGY

The Department of Clinical Psychology at Central India Institute of Mental Health and Neurosciences (CIIMHANS) was established in 2007 under the leadership of Dr. Pramod R. Gupta (Director & Psychiatrist). Committed to ethical and evidence-based mental health care, the department focuses on assessment, diagnosis, treatment, teaching, research, and prevention to enhance emotional, social, and behavioral well-being. It offers specialized psychological services, including psycho-diagnostic assessments, aptitude testing, and neuropsychological evaluations, using internationally validated tools such as MPQ, MMPI, MCMI, TCI, Rorschach Inkblot Test, and TAT. The treatment approaches integrate Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT), Rational Emotive Behavior Therapy (REBT), Mindfulness-Based CBT (MBCBT), Relapse Prevention Therapy (RPT), Dialectical Behavior Therapy (DBT), and Interpersonal and Social Rhythm Therapy (IPSRT) to provide personalized and effective interventions.

To address the growing need for skilled mental health professionals, the department introduced the M.Phil. in Clinical Psychology program in 2021 at the Central India Institute, which is recognized by the Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) with an annual intake of 12 students per batch. It also offers structured internship programs, ensuring hands-on clinical exposure and professional training. The department maintains a rigorous academic environment, conducting lectures, seminars, case discussions, and psychotherapy meetings for students of Clinical Psychology, Psychiatric Social Work, and Psychiatric Nursing. Additionally, trainees actively participate in journal clubs, interdisciplinary research, and departmental conferences, fostering a culture of continuous learning and innovation.







Clinical services:

The department is equipped with a state-of-the-art psychological assessment laboratory, supporting high-quality mental health services and research. It houses a range of tests for personality assessment (MMPI-II, EPQ, CPQ, RPFT, MCMI-III, etc.), neuropsychological evaluations (N-FAB, PGI-BBD, Raven's Progressive Matrices, AIIMS Battery, BGT-II, etc.), and cognitive and behavioral assessments (MISIC, DST, WAIS-IV, SBIS, and screening tests for learning disorders). Through its scientific rigor, ethical approach, and commitment to mental health advocacy, the Department of Clinical Psychology at CIIMHANS continues to be a leading center of excellence, dedicated to advancing mental health care, education, and research for a healthier and more inclusive society.

Departmental activities:

The Department of Clinical Psychology has well trained and qualified faculty members. The departmental conducts regular academic classes and weekly departmental seminars and psychotherapy meetings based on the course curriculum for the students as well as for students of other disciplines such as Psychiatric Social Work and Psychiatric Nursing. The trainees are required to present and participate in departmental case conferences, seminars and journal clubs.

D Laboratory

The department has well- equipped psychological assessment infrastructure to facilitate better mental health services and training mental health professionals. The laboratory is well stacked with various tests for assessment of personality(MMPI-II, Rorschach Inkblot Test, EPQ, CPQ,RPFT,MCMI-III, CAT, TAT & etc), Neuropsychological testing (N-FAB, PGI-BBD, Raven's Progressive Matrices, AIIMS Battery BGT-II and etc.), and other domains of human behaviour (MISIC, DST, WAIPIS, WAIS-IV, SBIS, various screening test learning disorders and etc).

DEPARTMENT OF PSYCHIATRIC SOCIAL WORK

The Department of Psychiatric Social Work at CIIMHANS was established in 2007 with the aim to enhancing social functioning by addressing individual and group dynamics, fostering social relationships, and improving interactions between individuals and their environments. To strengthen its academic offerings, the department introduced an M. Phil. in Psychiatric Social Work in 2021, affiliated with Hemchand Yadav University, Durg, with an annual intake of 30 students.



Clinical services:

The department provides comprehensive case assessments and psychosocial evaluations, offering therapeutic interventions such as individual counseling, cognitive and behavior modification therapies, group and marital therapy, family therapy, and community resource linkage. These services aim to enhance coping mechanisms, improve family dynamics, and connect patients with essential support systems.



Departmental activities:

Academically, the department conducts regular lectures, weekly seminars, psychotherapy meetings, case conferences, and research presentations to ensure indepth learning. Students receive practical training in psychiatric social work services, therapy, and community outreach, gaining hands-on experience under the supervision of experienced faculty. These initiatives equip students with the clinical and academic expertise needed to support individuals facing mental health challenges.
